Thank you for considering adopting a pet from the Whatcom Humane Society. Please look through the kennels! If you see an animal that you are interested in adopting, please return to the front office and ask a staff member for an adoption application.

BEFORE you visit with an animal, you must fill out an adoption application. The application will help us learn more about what you are looking for and assist us in making the most appropriate match with a companion animal for your home.

Don't forget...all dogs, cats, and rabbits need to be spayed or neutered **PRIOR** to leaving the shelter.

Once your adoption application is completed and approved, you will be given a time and date to pick up your new family member.

These pets are considered heroes because the higher adoption fee associated with these pets will help support ongoing animal care and veterinary programs in our domestic animal shelter.
